

LEGISLATIVE PROCESS FLOW CHART

Legislation may be introduced in either chamber. Similar measures often are introduced in both.



Measure must pass both the House and Senate in identical form before being presented to the President.



Legislation Presented to the President.

President signs measure

If President does not sign measure into law within a specified 10 days

Measure becomes law

If Congress is in session, measure becomes law

If Congress is not in session, measure does not become law

President vetoes measure

Measure does not become law unless both chambers override with 3/4 vote
